CIRCULAR

Dear Parents / Guardians,

Someone has rightly said, "Don't measure yourself by what you have accomplished, but by what you should have accomplished with your ability." Precisely so, we have not accomplished much but we can and we will with the coordination and cooperation of all the stakeholders.

Here below is the information and norms regarding Admission Procedure to Class XI (2024 -2025). Please read and understand.

- 1. Admission to + 2 Course (AISSCE) is by selection and choice. Students are admitted to Class XI on the basis of **their conduct and consistent and good academic report** in the previous classes. The selection for allocating Science Stream (P.C.M. / P.C.B.) or Commerce Stream will be strictly on the basis of merit. Such merit shall be determined on the basis of the performance of the qualifying examination (AISSE- X Board Exam), unless there are other disqualifying factors such as misconduct or any misdemeanor. The allocation of the streams i.e. Science Stream (P.C.M/P.C.B) or Commerce Stream will also depend upon the availability of seats in each stream.
- 2. The Principal of the School reserves the right to refuse admission to Class XI to the students who were involved in misconduct or misdemeanor.
- 3. In **Science Stream** we have **40 (Forty) seats**. In the **Commerce Stream** we have **40 (Forty) seats**, in which 20 (Twenty) seats are reserved for Commerce with Maths and 20 (Twenty) seats for Commerce with Informaties Practices.
- 4. **Admission procedure to Class XI for session 2024 2025, will start from 15th of April, 2024**. It will be based on the aptitude shown in the previous class (Class X –Pre- board) and the result of internal assessment by the teachers along with options given to us on the Application Form.
- 5. Details of the selected candidates (Stream wise) and Admission Procedures will be informed to the Parents and Students through the School Website.
- 6. The sure parameters for the Stream would be : -
 - (a) **PCM:** English + Physics + Chemistry + Mathematics along with Computer Science & Physical Education, (for 6 Subjects both). Seats 20, required percentage 80% minimum in Science & Mathematics.
 - (b) **PCB:** English + Physics + Chemistry + Biology along with Computer Science & Physical Education. (for 6 Subjects both). Seats 20, required percentage 80% minimum in Science & Computer.
 - (c) **Commerce with Mathematics:** English + Maths + Business Studies + Accounts + Economics along with Physical Education (for 6 Subjects both) Seats 20, required percentage 75% minimum in Mathematics.

(d) **Commerce with Informatics Practices:** English + Business Studies + Accounts + Economics along with Informatics Practices & Physical Education (for 6 Subjects- both) Seats - 20, required percentage 70% minimum in Mathematics & Computer.

- 7. The Subjects / Subject Combination chosen in Class XI and registered with the Board cannot be changed in Class XII.
- 8. Once admission is granted for Class XI, as per merit and choice of the student, it is expected that the student will have to appear for all the tests during the year, as admission to Class XII is not automatic. If a student of Class XI does not secure a minimum of **33**% in each subject and have a minimum of **75**% of attendance he/she will not be eligible/consider for promotion to Class XII. Parents are requested to ensure that their wards attend classes regularly. Please discourage the wards taking tuitions outside for it is mere waste of time, energy and money. Private tuitions by our teachers is forbidden and if compelled please let the Principal know of it **immediately.**
- 9. The students, who wish to continue their studies over here (St. Clare's School, Unit II, Kaulakha Devori Road, Agra) are to fill-in the attached Application Form with the subjects of their choice approved and endorsed by the parents can submit the School Office before 20th April 2024.
- 10. Students from other Schools and boards can apply for the Admission along with Pre-Board Result. Admission will be granted only after the board results (X-Board) based on the merit and availability of the seats. Admission fees is applicable only for the External Students [New Admission].
- 11. Last date to submit the Application Form for Internal Students [St. Clare's School, Unit-II] will be 20th April 2024.
